The University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) welcomes international students interested in studying for an academic year or for a full term of undergraduate studies to apply for this needs-based scholarship.

The purpose of the scholarship is to foster cross-cultural learning and understanding of all peoples around the globe.

Individuals graduating from foreign high schools (or completing the appropriate secondary education proficiency exam as required for admission to the university) and/or students transferring from colleges/universities outside of the United States of America who can travel to Juneau and engage in course work, campus life and community events are eligible.

This scholarship is intended for international students (F-1 visa) who travel to Alaska from their home countries to take classes on the Juneau campus and engage in the community.

Students are required to fulfill international admissions requirements which can be found online at :

All applicants are required to submit educational and financial records and an English language proficiency test score, to complete the UAS Placement Tests (English and mathematics), and meet all other admissions requests.

As a recipient of the International Peace Scholarship, individuals are required to maintain immigration status, obtain appropriate insurance, and engage in opportunities to share their culture with other students, faculty, staff and community members.
